

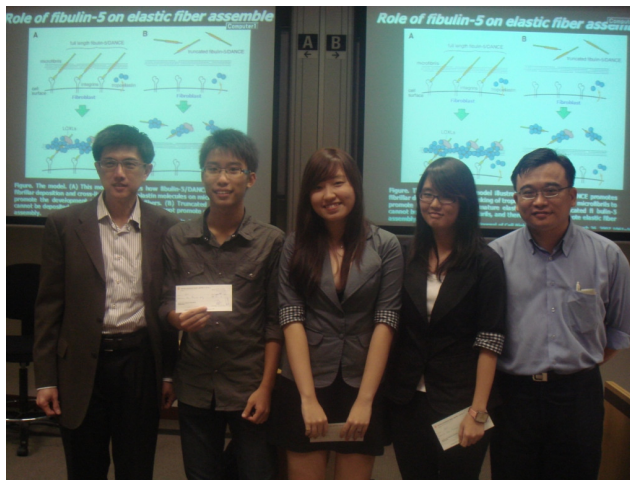

Three students from the newly launched Diploma in Perfumery and Cosmetic Science from the School of Chemical and Life Sciences, Singapore Polytechnic received bursary awards from the Singapore Society of Cosmetic Scientists (SCSS) last month. The SGD 1,000 bursaries were meant to help students with financial difficulties but keen on pursuing an education in the areas of Cosmetic Science. Currently, in Singapore, there is a lack of formal education that trains graduates for the Cosmetics, Personal Care as well as the Fragrance industries. The new Diploma in Perfumery and Cosmetic Science hopes to address the gap and in three years' time, offer skilled manpower to service the lucrative Personal Care, Cosmetics, Fragrance as well as Chemical sectors when it produces its first batch of graduates.
